

In a past life Tim was a Signwriter and went on to further study at TAFE. University. and a range of courses to prepare him to undertake the exciting and challenging enterprise the farm has become. A long-term illness forced Tim to look at what we eat and good nutrition. The journey of the study of Organic Farming and a farming system based on Permaculture Principles commenced.

Tim often says he feels well out of his depth most days trying to run a charity alongside the farm. Without passionate, capable, qualified staff and a dedicated team of volunteers (including a long suffering wife and family), supported by our local community, the charity would not continue to achieve great outcomes with young people.

The brand is PhycoHealth which is now sold online and in retail throughout Australia. The seaweed grows 50 x more food per area than other crops and leaves no waste, reduces greenhouse gases, uses no water, protects coastal ecosystems and relieves pressure on land for food production.



Miniature ponies originate from the Falabella pony of Argentina. They have been bred for their small size, gentle nature and calm disposition. Miniature ponies can be shown competitively or kept as pets, with the added advantage of mowing your lawn. Because of their small size they require less paddock space than full sized ponies and they do well on pasture

Classified as endangered by the Rare Breeds Trust of Australia, Ryelands are one of the nine heritage breeds that founded the Australian Sheep and Wool industry.

Once a popular terminal site of prime lambs, these naturally hornless sheep were used in the development of the poll dorset to introduce the polled gene. The ewes make excellent mothers. We are currently trying to develop coloured Ryelands extending their appeal to hobby farmers and home spinners.

Nigerian Dwarf goats are naturally small in size, friendly and gentle. They will find a place on small acreages aiding in weed control and as mini milkers. Their milk has a high butterfat content and can be used to produce a cheese that is valued for its earthy flavour. Goats milk cheese can be substituted in practically any recipe where cows milk cheese is used.

Alpacas were imported into Australia in 1987 from Peru and Bolivia. They are farmed primarily for their fleece production, although there is a gourmet meat market. The luxury fibre that they produce has outstanding fineness, softness and warmth and come in a range of natural colours from white through fawns, browns, greys and true black. Alpacas are used as herd guards for sheep and goats.
